I hate being the gallery police, but a question has come up about some pieces in the past and in the last show. Do not forget copyright laws and what is appropriate for judged shows. I'm not accusing anyone but just passing on a reminder.

If you are copying a painting someone else has done, it is not to be put in a judged show whether copyright applies or not. If you are coping a photo from a magazine, that photo is the property of the person taking the photo and should not be put in any of our shows.

Sorry, but is against the law, and it is not your creation. You can

use these references if not more than 10 percent is recognizable from the reference you are using. The other 90 percent should be your creation. You can paint from your own photos or from someone else's if they give you permission to use the photo. We depend on your honesty since we don't see all the magazines printed, but occasionally someone comes across the picture that was copied in a magazine where it was printed.

Of course you can copy anything for your practice just don't enter it in a judged show. Old paintings that are out of the copyright period can be copied and entered in regular shows where they are not judged. On these paintings they need to identified of the back with, "copy of painting by Van Gogh" by Dorrine Sadilek. Any questions call me.

One last thing. Patt Skinner is very ill with severe generalized pain which, last I heard, my be do to medication which, hopefully, can be changed. She was not able to do the sitting calendar this show change so I did it. I noticed that some of you do not abide by the sitting requirements. Each artist must sit 3-3hr. shifts or sit 1-3hr. shift and pay the sitting fee for the other shifts. Some artists have told me they will check their calendar and sign up later which they don't do.

I hate writing these kinds of articles or calling anyone to remind them. This is your gallery. We are a membership organization, and it takes everyone's cooperation.

On a lighter note, we had something happen in sales that is kind of unique. From the Summer Show Pat Cuellar sold two photos. They were both of the Genoa Bar and the wagon there. Then the first Tuesday of the current show we sold Ric Rose's painting of the Genoa Bar. It's really strange because we have had many paintings and photos of the Genoa Bar in the past, but they were not such a HOT seller. We may have sold one, but not had a run on them. Congratulations to both of you. Also sold out of the Summer Show was Ralph Phillip's photo of the owl, "Here's Looking at You."
